President's Report: Darya McClain

 We were very busy toward the end of last semester with the holiday shop, Turkey Trot and our Rubio's Community Builder which was very well attended.

Treasurer's Report: Darya McClain

- We have an update budget report from Peter. The holiday shop had a net income of \$685, which was less than our project income of \$1000 but it was still really fun for the students.
- We received \$500 from Kohl's Cares for their involvement in the Pumpkin Walk.
- Box Tops have brought in \$980. We need to encourage more families to download the app since clip tops are being phased out. We will post a video on Facebook on how to use the app. We will also being showing the video during Meet the Teacher night in the future.
- We received \$185 from our Wildflower Community Builder.
- Wells Fargo matched a donation of \$600.
- We have already raised more money from Community Builders this year than we did for the entire year last year.
- We discussed a "wish list" of items to purchase. Included was another large order of pencil sharpeners and discussion of building a Snack Shack/Student Store.

- Our application for A+ has been submitted and we will find out January 21 if we are to move on to the next step with a site visit.

Committee Reports

Decades Dance: Jennifer Dauscha and Nicole Martinez

- The committee was able to salvage some decorations from last year but they may need more. They will be putting notes in the catalog for next year about the proper way to take down and store decorations so that they last longer.
- More bins are needed for soda, ice, etc. We have 4 new drink carts that should work well. More helium is also needed for balloons but this may prove difficult since there is a helium shortage. Pizza is estimated to cost approximately \$450.
- In an effort to keep students inside for the dance, the committee is trying to come up with ideas for barricading the playground. We may use A-frame signs and caution take to keep students off the playground. We may also add a slot on the SignUp Genius for a parent volunteer to monitor students.

 The committee will be contacting Corona High School and the Tempe Dance Academy to find dance students who may volunteer at the dance.

- There is no camel this year so there will be a schoolwide vote for an animal for teachers to kiss.
- We would like to add a first aid station and a lost and found station.
 We may ask parents who are medical professionals to volunteer at this station.
